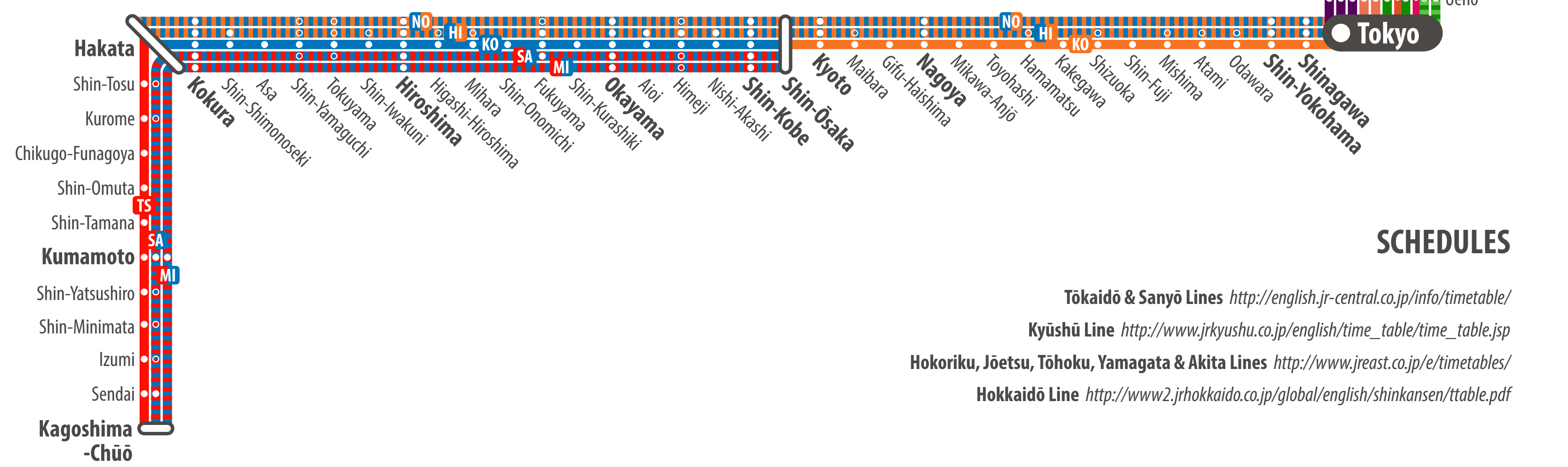

Mini-Shinkansen **KO** **TS**
On the Akita and Yamagata Lines, top speed is 130 km/hr (80 mph).
On the Tōhoku Line, Komachi and Tsusbasa trains are attached to Hayabusa and Yamabiko trains.

TA In winter, some Tanagawa trains go to the Gala-Yuzawa ski resort north of Echigo-Yuzawa.

KO Some Kodama trains go past Hakata, to Hakata-Minami, as Limited Express trains.

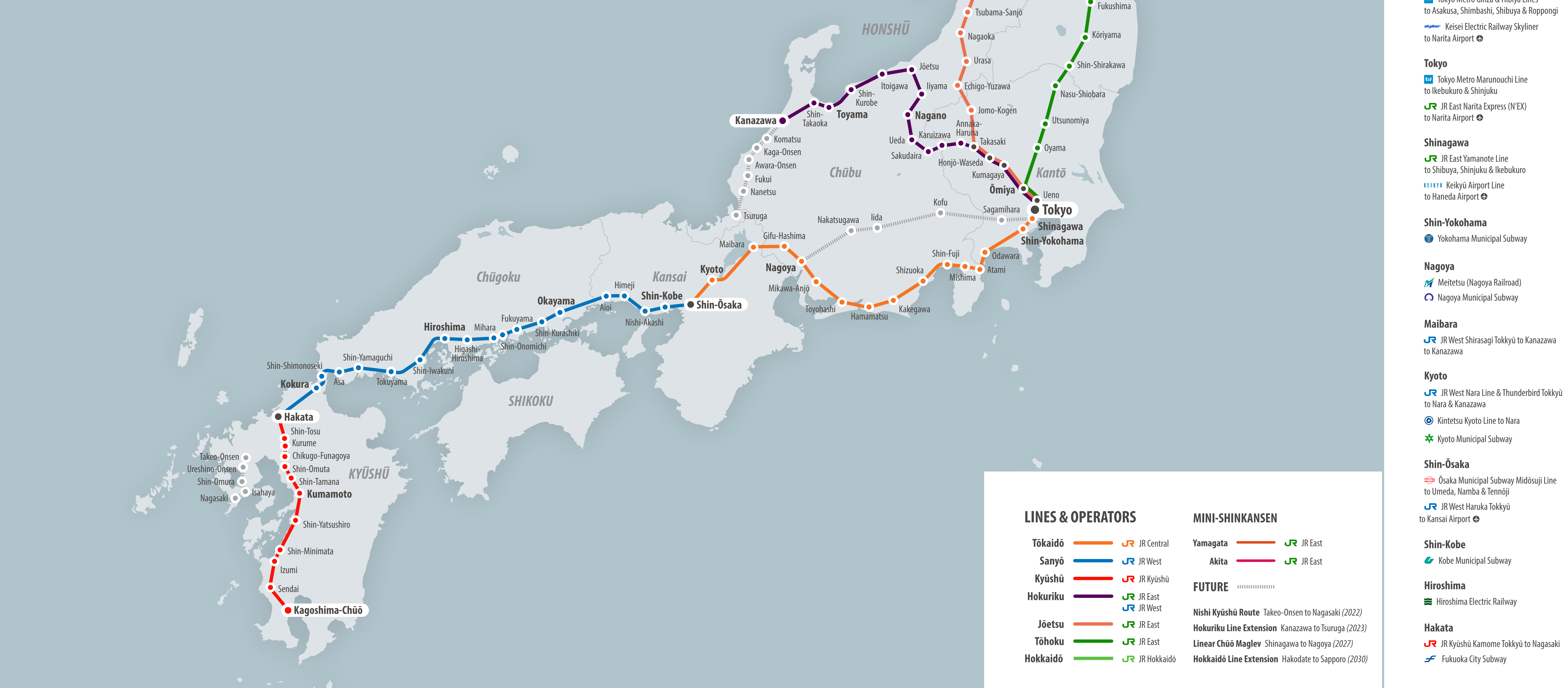
